NDIS plans and processes are being put into place to encourage employment, micro-enterprises, and most importantly, provide care and support to improve the quality of life for our elders and people with disabilities.




## HLT40113 Certificate IV in Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander Primary Health Care
